This school has been truly life-changing for us! We would always start a school year excited and full of hope, only to be discouraged and burned out before the end of the first quarter. Teachers and staff failed to understand my kids' needs, accommodations were planned but never quite implemented, and eventually the act of even going to school put their nervous systems into fight or flight. We missed so much school due to anxiety that my kids were labeled as truant.

We tried homeschooling, and learned the struggles of neurodivergent parents trying to teach their neurodivergent kids. It was not the right fit for us.

We are more than halfway through the year at OCS, and we have missed less than a handful of days. The kids are always eager to go to school now! They're being challenged and doing work that I feel is more meaningful and engaging, while also taking part in activities that nurture their creativity and curiosity.

Best of all, they have a teacher they trust and feel safe with, who understands the limitations of their nervous systems.
